

### **HARDWARE KIT:**

- 1- LOWER & UPPER CLAMP ASSEMBLY (4)
- 2- DRIVER & PASSENGEER LATCH PLATE
- 3-BOLT, M6 X 16MM BUTTON HEAD FLANGE (12)

#### **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- » Torx 40mm socket
- » TORX 25MM SOCKET
- » TORX 30MM SOCKET
- » 4MM ALLEN WRENCH
- » RATCHET

# 900 Trail Doors Instructions (P152D002)

\*\*\*Do not discard stock hardware or door latch assembly! You will be re-using them on your new trail doors.\*\*\*



First take off the stock door with a t40 torx socket and ratchet. (3 bolts)



Pull the cover off the stock door by removing the 6 - t25 bolts.



Remove the paddle latch from the door by removing the 2 - t30 bolts.



Install the new trail door on to the car with the 3 t40 bolts that you removed in the first step.



Install the paddle latch on your new Pro Armor trail doors using the provided latch plate with the t30 bolts that you removed from the previous step & 3-M6 bolts in hardware kit.



With the 3 bolts snug align the door so that it opens and closes smoothly. Make sure it latches. Then tighten the 3 t40 bolts.

There is also adjustment in the latch plate assembly. You can adjust this with the 3 m6 bolts using a 4mm Allen wrench.



Next put on the quarter panel assembly with the hardware that came with your doors. (2 half clamps and 3 6mm bolts) Tighten with a 4mm Allen wrench.



Now double check all hardware so that it is fastened tightly and correctly. Repeat these steps for opposite door.
